

Central Arizona Riding Academy, will be hosting a Musical Freestyle Clinic with Klassic Kur's Terri Ciotti Gallo on November 8-9, 2025. This clinic will focus on the rider.

Saturday Morning's Program will cover music, choreography and some judging criteria. Following Lunch the program will move to the covered arena. Audio and video components are included to compliment the program. Sunday's program will focus on 'Do It Yourself' Freestyles with a morning lecture and 4-6 rider slots.



Klassic Kur's Terry Ciotti Gallo is the best known name in U.S. freestyle. Her freestyles have been presented in the Olympics, World Equestrian Games, World Dressage Masters, Pan American Games, and NAJYRC, with two World Cup titles. Clients include Steffen Peters (Udon, Grandeur, Floriano, Ravel, Legolas); Debbie McDonald (Beaurivage, Brentina); Guenter Seidel (Graf George, Foltaire, Nikolaus 7, Aragon, U II, CR Wylea); George Williams (Rocher, Marnix); Adrienne Lyle (Wizard, Felix); and Charlotte Bredahl (Monsieur, Komo).

The Saturday three hour seminar takes riders on a step-by-step journey of finding music that is right for their horse, a review of the rules, planning effective choreography and much more. This session is beneficial for Pony Club, National and FEI levels.

The mounted sessions accommodate riders from Training Level through Grand Prix in 45 minute time slots each. All mounted participants will go through a tempo analysis, learn to ride to the beat of the music, and have choreography for one gait that is appropriate for their level. Many riders come to a clinic with specific objectives and we are happy to help them meet their goals. This allows for flexibility in the mounted sessions.

Auditors will share in the learning by getting an inside look at how Musical Freestyles are created (Saturday morning) and how Riders navigate the process of creating their Freestyle (Saturday afternoon and Sunday). Auditors may attend both days for \$85 or a single day for \$45. Lunches available on grounds for a fee. Rider Participants \$350, which includes lecture, ride, and lunches
